Founded in 1962, the primary mission of the U.S. Capitol Historical Society is to educate people across our country about the Capitol and the people who work in it in a manner that inspires, in the words of our authorizing legislation, “inspired patriotism.”

For more than a decade, our **We the People Constitution Tour™** has taught over 20,000 students about the underlying concepts of the Constitution by combining classroom study with a day-long interactive tour of historic sites in Washington, D.C. This free, high-impact program encourages informed participation in the democratic process and leaves students more likely to vote, engage in public service, and understand their rights and responsibilities as Americans.

THE CAPITOL COMMITTEE
